

# CAMP EBENEZER RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Parents must sign their child(ren) in and out daily.
2. Staff will not dispense medication to children.
3. Camp activities end at 3:45 p.m. All children MUST be picked up by 4:00 pm daily. Late pickups may result in the child(ren) being dismissed from camp.
4. Follow all directions given by the director and staff.
5. Absolutely no weapons allowed (Swiss Army Knives, Pocket knives, etc...)
6. No profanity or fighting will be tolerated in the camp. Disciplinary action for violation of camp rules lie with the Camp Director or Assistant Director.
7. No vandalizing or destruction of camp property. No destruction of other people's property, No stealing, No touching of others personal belongings without their permission. (Parents will be liable for any damage done by their children).
8. No electronic devices (stereos, iPods, portable video games, etc....) without the permission of camp staff.
9. Parents will be contacted if their child(ren) become(s) unruly during camp and can be sent home at the discretion of the director. Parents will be expected to pick up their child(ren).
10. No cigarettes, alcoholic beverages, or drugs (Any medication should be turned over to staff members); No use of tobacco, intoxicants, or fireworks is permitted. Campers will not bring any material that may be a hazard to themselves or others.
11. No leaving the camp site.
12. Please dispose of trash and paper appropriately.
13. Proper conduct between genders must be observed at all times. There will be no "dating" at camp. Any "dating" will be reported to parents.
14. Wrestling, horseplay, tackle football, pushing, hitting, or any other activity that puts camper safety risk is not permitted.
15. Campers are responsible for their own money and personal items.
16. Campers must be well groomed and appropriately attired
17. Any damage to property by campers will be paid for by the camper or his/her parents.
18. Camp tee shirts should be worn for the duration of all off-site activities (with the exception of swim days & water parks).
