What Camp Offers

Camp Ebenezer offers a variety of activities to stimulate both intellectual and physical. Yearly, the activities are reviewed to ensure they are in line with the campers' needs.

Have a nutritious breakfast and lunch that's provided free of charge to all handicapped and anyone under the age of 18, except for those children with food allergies.

The class sizes will vary depending on the number of campers registered; ideally a class will be less than 12 campers. Counselor will have lesson plans for each session. Each class will last 30 minutes, except for Bible which will conclude after 45 minutes.

Employment Opportunities
